

Whose turn is it, anyway? (Yellow triangles 1, 5, 6)

Pin the flow donkey style (Green triangles 1, 7)

Bodabing Bodabingo (Pink triangles 3, 4)

The Great Training Hunt (Purple triangles 2, 8)

1 Rolling out a complicated computer system? Use pin the flow to teach business process steps in your system. Make it fun by taping large symbols on the wall that can be re-arranged. Velcro is super.

2 Don't read the powerpoint! Give students a fill-in-the-blank and multiple choice worksheet to find the facts and figures so the lesson won't be a yawn!

3 Bingo, in oh so many different ways. First, place a unique marker on the free spots - the company or department logo, for instance. Have the students make bingo by getting all the words in a circle or all the words around the border (instead of those in straight lines).

4 Line up 10 people. Assign each a word and ask them to say their word. Then, pass a ball to a person in the line. Say a sentence using one of the words and have the person pass the ball to that person. If they pass to the wrong person, they have to sit down.

5 Toss a ball to a student and ask the student to answer the question. That student then has the option of tossing the ball to another student. Each person can dodge an answer just two times.

6 Assign each student a number. Using a spinner with numbers or dice, spin the dial to select a student to answer the question. That student then chooses a student to answer the next question.

7 Use pin the flow with a donkey head and tail to teach new business processes. Create symbols or words for each process and have students tape the process steps in the correct order. Occasionally, a student should spin and try to pin the step in place blindfolded.

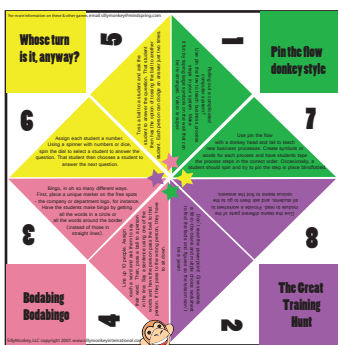
8 Give the teams different parts of the module to read. Provide a worksheet to all students, and ask them to go to the various teams to find the answers.

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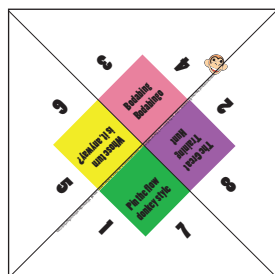


How to fold your **SillyMonkey** monkey catcher!

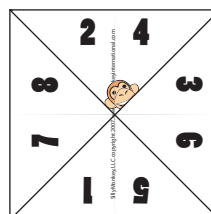
STEP 1: Cut around the square
